

DAISY DARLING FABRIC FLOWER DIECUT PATTERN INSTRUCTIONS

1. Cut Out Your Diecut

Cut out the diecut with your machine using the Clean Cut Fabric Interfacing (purchased at your local craft shop or at silhouetteameria.com.) Use the instructions on the package to prepare for cutting. You will need to cut out at leave 1 of each piece provided in the svg file. For a fuller flower, cut an extra piece large and medium piece.



2. Hot Glue the Petals

Carefully dab a small amount of glue to the middle side of a petal and glue the opposite side of the petal together (as shown in illustration). Repeat with all the petals on all the flower pieces.



3. Hot Glue the Flower Pieces Together
Dab a small amount of hot glue to the center of each of
the pieces. Rotate the flowers so that the petals
intersect with each other.



3. Embellish

Embellish with a button in the center of the flower or add a kabob stick as a stem. Sew or hot glue on the button. Use the flower for barrettes, home decor, pins, or other great sewing projects!
