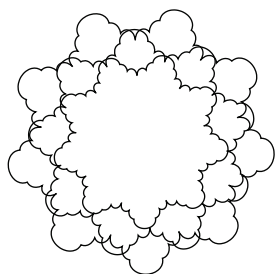
- diecut pattern (purchased from carinagardner.com or silhouetteamerica.com)
- button or embellishment

- diecutting machine
- hot glue gun and sticks
- thread (if sewing button)
- scissors
- hand sewing needle (if sewing button)

-  fabric wrong-side

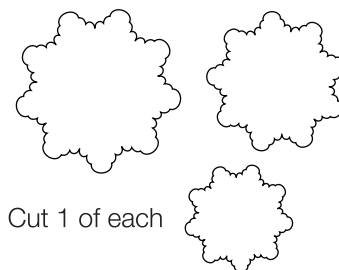


LACY FLOWER FABRIC DIECUT PATTERN INSTRUCTIONS

1. Cut Out Your Diecut

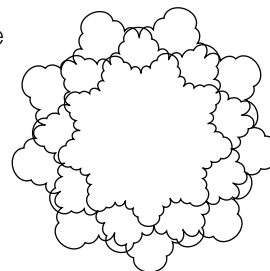
Cut out the diecut with your machine using the Clean Cut Fabric Interfacing (purchased at your local craft shop or at silhouetteamerica.com). Use the instructions on the package to prepare for cutting. You will need to cut 1 of each piece provided in the svg file.

2. Hot Glue the Pieces Together

Carefully pull the flower pieces from the cutting mat. Dab a small amount of hot glue to the center of each of the pieces and place them as in the illustration. Crumple the fabric slightly to get more dimension if desired.



3. Embellish

Embellish with a button in the center of the flower or add a kabob stick as a stem. Sew or hot glue on the button. Use the flower for barrettes, home decor, pins, or other great sewing projects!
