


## pillow instructions

- 1. Fold the ruffle in half. Use a long stitch/gathering stitch along the raw edge and pull the end threads to create a gather.
- 2. With wrong-sides together, place the two green/pink primrose for the pillow together. Sandwich the ruffle between the pillow pieces with the raw edges matching up. Pin into place (See Diagram B). Sew along the edge. Leave 2 inches unsewn.
- 3. Turn the pillow right-side out and fill with stuffing.
- 4. Hand sew the opening shut once stuffed folding in the raw edge.





# primrose garden™ 18 inch doll quilt and pillow instructions

Fabric designed by Carina Gardner Quilt designed by Carina Gardner Quilt skill level: Beginner

Finished Size: about 16" x 18.5"

NOTE: Please read through all instructions before starting this quilt. All seams are 1/4" inless otherwise noted.

### yardage

1/2 yards of white pink swiss fabric 1/2 yards of green/pink primrose fabric 1/2 yards for binding fat quarter or 18" x 22" for back of quilt

#### tools needed

Ruler/rotary ruler and/or yardstick Scissors and/or rotary cutter and mat Hand-sewing needle and thread Iron Stuffing

## blocks/cutting

For the quilt:

45 green/pink primrose blocks (2.5" x 2.5") 45 white pink swiss blocks (2.5" x 2.5")

#### For the pillow:

2 green/pink primrose for the pillow (4.5" x 6.5") 1 white pink swiss blocks for the ruffle (3" x 21")

## quilt instructions

- 1. Use Diagram A to layout the quilt (checkerboard pattern). Sew together blocks by by horizontal rows. Press seams all the same direction every other row to create nested seams.
- 2. Sew together the horizontal rows.
- 3. Use fleece or batting and layer the backing, batting, and the pieced quilt top and machine quilt together.
- 4. Bind with a complimentary Primrose Garden fabric.
