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



CUTTING THE FABRIC


Basic Layout for FLAG (A) + BLOCK (C)

44 inch fabric




Layout for Up and Down Fabrics for FLAG (A) + BLOCK (C) (suitable for Brown Birds, Patchwork Birds, ect.)

Layout for White Flower FLAG (B) (Flags-8 will fit across) (suitable for Brown Birds, Patchwork Birds, ect.)



TIP: Cut tightly or directly again an edge you have already cut to ensure that you will get the most out of your fabric.

ASSEMBLING THE QUILT

Sew together all the pieces horizontally first (A + B). 1. Sew together the flags. (5 rows of flags)




 Sew together the small 2.5" x 4" blocks (C). (18 in one length, 4 rows of blocks)

3. Sew together patterns (D + E)
(2 in one length, 15 rows of D and E)


ASSEMBLING THE QUILT (continued)

4. Sew together rows using the chart below.



HOW TO CUT BIAS STRIPS FOR BINDING


Open your fabric. Lay it RIGHT side up. Fold one corner RIGHT sides together matching one selvage edge to make a triangle and press the edge. Open the fabric and cut along the creased edge.

Wrong-side of fabric

Measure and mark 2 1/2" from each end of the cut edge. Continue to cut strips by measuring out 2 1/2" evenly along the original cut.




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

ATTACH BORDER TO PATCHWORK FRONT

Square off patchwork by measuring each side. Ease your borders to get the same length on each side. Attach vertical borders.



Attach the horizontal border pieces to finish off the front of the quilt.



PUT TOGETHER BACK OF QUILT


The back of the quilt needs to be 4" longer on every side to be machine quilted. Measure the final front and add 8" to the final size to determine the size of the quilt back.

MACHINE QUILTING

Use a walking foot to quilt together batting, front, and back of quilt OR send to a machine quilter.

PREPARE BINDING

Join the bias strips into one continuous piece by placing the end of the strips perpendicular to each other with the RIGHT sides together. Stitch across the diagonal edges. Trim the edges. Continue to sew together strips until you have a piece measuring at least 345" long.




ATTACH BINDING

Fold the bias strips in half. Match the raw edge of the bias strip with the raw edge of the quilt.

Sew together the bias strip to the front of the quilt.

Close with a perfect bind.







Hand-sew the binding to the back of the quilt.
