# Thankful Banner

This is a wonderful activity to do throughout the holidays. It's a great way to record and remind us of what we have to be grateful for. We recommend making the leaves all at once and keeping a jar nearby so that children and adults can grab one to write on and add to string.

## MATERIALS LIST

- Bright cardstock or cover-weight paper
- String or ribbon
- Glitter Mist (optional)
- Clothespins



## STEP 1

Print the pattern sheet on different colored papers from your printer. We like gold, orange, red, brown, and olive green for autumn colors. Change the colors for the holiday season (for example, you could continue this through Christmas and use red and green paper).



## STEP 2

Cut out the leaves and birds.



## STEP 3

(Optional) Use a glitter mist in autumn colors or gold to spray the pieces.



## STEP 4

Write, scribble, or draw the things you are thankful for on the pieces and hang the banner!



## STEP 5

(Optional) Keep the pieces and add to a scrapbook or hold on to and add to the next holiday season.
